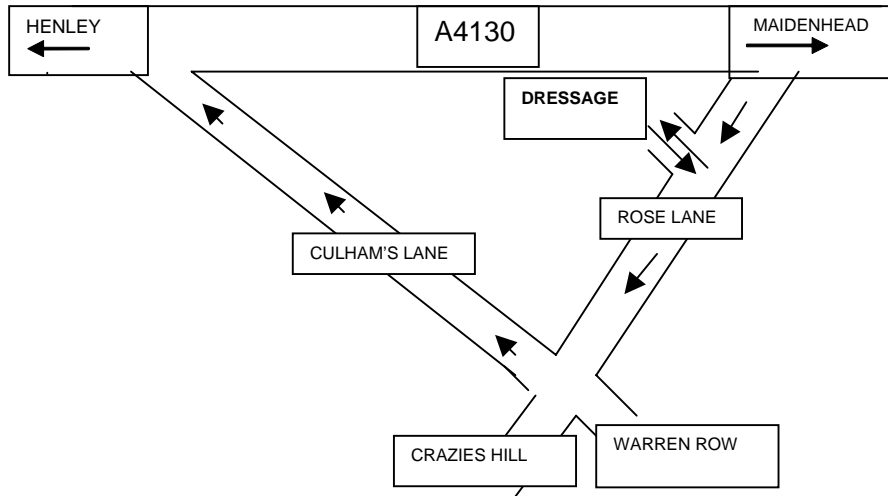

## ELIGIBILITY & SECTIONS

### Classes 1 & 2

Section A Combination of Horse & Rider not to have been placed in a prelim test (where there were 8 or more entries) or won an Intro/walk and trot test before May 2009

Section B Open

Please note: spurs may not be worn

### Classes 3 & 4

Section A Combination of Horse & Rider not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a prelim test (where there were 8 or more entries)

Section B Combination of Horse & Rider not to have gained British Dressage points

### Class 5

Section A Combination of Horse & Rider not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a novice test (where there were 8 or more entries)

Section B Open

**Class 6** Open

## SUMMER SERIES CHAMPIONS\*

At each of these three competitions, points will be awarded to all Horse/Rider combinations placed 1st-6th in classes 3 to 6, plus Section A of classes 1 & 2.

At the end of the series the points will be totalled and a **Champions rug will be awarded** to the Horse/Rider combination with the most points at Intro/Walk and Trot\*\*, Preliminary, and at Novice/Elementary.

\*To qualify for the Champions prize, competitors must have attended at least 2 of our summer dressage competitions

\*\*Only riders competing in Section A of classes 1 & 2 will be eligible to win the Intro/Walk and Trot Champions rug.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedules, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
3. Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, spurs etc. or other actions which the Judges or Officials consider warrants such penalty.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. ALL RIDERS, whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear; PAS 015 or BSEN 1384, or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard but riders have to be responsible for their own safety. Failure to wear correct headgear will incur elimination.
5. The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
6. Entries may be refused without reason being given and there will be no entitlement to any refund of entry unless a class is cancelled due to insufficient entries, or a Medical/Veterinary Certificate is produced. Up to 25% of entry money may be retained to cover administration costs.
7. Change of horse or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void. Change of both horse and rider will not be accepted.
8. ALL DOGS must be kept on leads at all times.
9. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules - our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
10. Dressage - No competitor may ride more than 2 horses in any class, at the discretion of the organiser.
