# Flu Jab Rules - 2024

There is a new directive from British Equestrian along with the other disciplines to change the primary injection course intervals following some research that has been carried out. Some of you will be aware the British Horse Racing Authority changed a couple of years ago. The intervals will be as below.

This does not mean that those who have vaccinations that are current and correct need to restart, the new intervals will be for restarts and new courses from 1 January 2024 only.
